

Chipping Sodbury and Monarch's Way.

The Frome Valley Walkway joins another long distance footpath at the north-eastern edge of Chipping Sodbury, **the Monarch's Way**. This 610 mile route traces the journey taken by Charles II when he fled after the Battle of Worcester in 1651. It crosses the Cotswolds before heading south west to the Mendips and along the south coast, where the king successfully escaped to France.
